5.Please keep the player be connected with PC when formatting the player or downloading files.
6.The incorrect way of save and export files may cause data lose, the important data please do the backup copy.
7.No matter the player is on or off, once it connects with computer, it could be charged.

## Cell electrical quantity

Show the present battery electric quantity:
It displayed as red block when battery is full.
It displayed as blank when battery is pretty low.

## Basic operation

- Enter into main menu

Short press " $M$ " to enter main menu, Long press " $M$ " to return main menu.



- ON/OFF

Press button to "ON" position, and long press " $>$ II" to turn on. Long press " II" button to power off when at working status, long press " 1 " to turn off. If long time haven't been used, please turn the player to OFF button.

- Play /Pause

Short press " II " button for play or pause function under playing status.

- Volumn adjustment

Under playing status, short press "VOL" button, the No. which shows the volumn will be flicked; then short press " $\boldsymbol{\omega}$ " to increase the volumn or short press " 4 " to decrease the volumn.

## -Record/Pause

Choose Record mode, short press "M" to recording status, double click
" 1 " to start or pause recording, long press to save the record file and exit to main menu.
