

# Important safety information

## I. Mobile phone usage

(1) Keep the phone and its accessories out of children's reach.

(2) Keep the phone dry. Rain, moisture and liquids can damage the phone. Do not use chemical cleaning solvents to clean the phone. Do not attempt unauthorized disassembly of the cell phone. If liquid damage happens, turn off the phone and send it to MEIZU Authorized Service Center for inspection and repair. Do not open the back cover, or use heating equipment (such as hair dryers, microwave ovens, etc.) for drying. If you have any questions, please contact MEIZU.

(3) Do not operate the device in extreme temperatures (  $< -10^{\circ}\text{C}$  or  $> 55^{\circ}\text{C}$  ), as it can shorten the life of the device and damage the battery.

(4) Do not drop, knock or shake the device, as it can damage the internal circuit board.

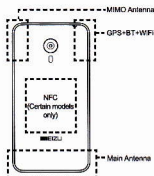
(5) Do not repair or attempt to repair the phone without authorization. If there is any problem, please consult MEIZU After-Sale Service Center promptly, or send the phone to MEIZU Authorized Service Center for inspection and repair.

(6) Prolonged use may result in the phone emitting some heat. This is normal.

(7) Do not break or alter without authorization the built-in antennas of the phone, otherwise the efficiency may decrease and the SAR may exceed the recommended limit. Holding the phone by the parts where the antennas are installed is not recommended, because a capping hand may affect the antenna performance and cause higher transmitting power.

(8) Do not use metallic bags or metal-sprayed cases in order to avoid interference to the antenna performance.

(9) Do not place heavy objects on the phone to avoid damage to the touchscreen.



## II. Mobile security and backup

The device supports connections over the Internet and other protocols, like computers, the device may be exposed to viruses, malicious information or applications, and other harmful content. Please only accept connectivity requests and download files from reliable sources. Back up important information to prevent loss.

## III. Battery

This product contains a lithium-ion polymer battery. If not properly handled, there may be fire or combustion dangers. Do not disassemble the battery.

IV. To prevent possible hearing damage, do not listen at high volumes for long periods.



V. Do not use the phone in the following environments:

- (1) Gas stations, chemical storage warehouses, or near a flammable gas or other chemicals.
- (2) Hospital operating rooms, emergency rooms and intensive care units, to avoid interference with medical devices.
- (3) In aircrafts, follow the aviation safety requirements and turn off your cell phone when necessary.
- (4) When driving, for the sake of your and other people's safety, do not use the phone.
- (5) During a lightning storm, it is advised not to use the phone outdoors.

## VI. Traffic safety

Research has shown that talking or texting while driving increases the risk of accident.

- (1) If you want to use the phone in the car, use hands-free devices specially designed for in-car use.
- (2) Make sure your mobile phone and hands-free devices do not hinder the car's airbags or any other safety equipment from functioning properly.

NOTICE: The precautions are not limited to the matters mentioned above; please comply with the restrictions of different occasions; some occasions might need not only the flight mode, but total shutdown of the cellphone.
