
- The Grill Light use 3 AA batteries.
- Use a screwdriver to remove the screw on bottom, Remove the cover and insert the batteries and align the battery with + and mark.
- Close the battery cover
- Do not mix old and new batteries



- Do not mix alkaline, standard (Carbon-Zinc) or rechargeable (Nickel-Cadmium) batteries
- Remove batteries when storing product for extended periods of time
- Avoid contact with water as moisture can damage Grill Light

MOUNTING THE GRILL LIGHT:

- 1. Allow the grill to cool completely prior to mounting the grill light
- 2. Raise the grill lid to the fully open position.
- 3. Position the light along the handle at a location where it will not interfere with normal operation.
- And allows you to close the lid without hitting the front of the grill.
- 4. Tighten the thumb screw finger tight. Do not over tighten. Close the lid slowly to make sure it will not interfere.
- 5. Turn On or Turn Off the unit by pressing the on/off button on the top of the light.

USE AND CARE:

- 1. Store Grill Light indoors when not in use.
- 2. Grill Light can be cleaned by gently wiping with a damp towel. DO

NOT IMMERSE IN WATER.

- 3. Remove batteries if Grill Light is to be unused for two months or more, since batteries could leak and damage the grill Light.
- 4. Do not incinerate, compact, or disassemble batteries.
- 5. Recycle old batteries whenever possible. If recycling is unavailable in your area, dispose of old batteries in accordance with local regulations.
