
Turntable to MP3 converter Quick Start Guide


Thanks for purchasing ezcap613 Turntable to MP3 converter. The following guides you how to set. Hope this device will bring you nice digital experience.

With this ezcap613 Turntable to MP3 converter, you can easily transfer your vinyl record to MP3 format. It can directly convert to a plug USB flash or Micro SD card, no pc required.

Features:




- 1. PLATTER Place your record here.
- 2. TONEARM Comes with a ready to use pre-balanced tone arm and cartridge.
- 3. ARM CLIP This specially designed arm clip secures the tone arm while at rest or when not in use. The arm clip has been designed to remain in the up position while unlocked. When a record is on the platter, place the arm clip down to avoid scratching your vinyl.



4. LINE OUT – Connect to speaker, so can enjoy the playing music.
5. USB OTG – For plug USB Flash disk in, so can save the converted MP3 files.

- 6. MICRO SD For plug micro SD card in, so can save the files.
- 7. MINI USB For power supply with 5V DC adapter




REC/STOP BUTTON – Press to start convert (record), press again to stop

PLAY/STOP BUTTON – Press to playback the converted MP3 file in USB flash.


PREV BUTTON – When playback, press to play previous file. NEXT BUTTON – When playback, press to play next file.

How to play your recorders:


1. Undo and lower arm clip.




3. Place the record on the platter.




2. Raise the tone arm, then move it to the side.



4. Lower the tone arm onto record; the record will begin playing.



5. When finished, raise the tone arm and return it to rest on the arm clip.



Recording in manually mode

Note: This device support both USB flash and Micro SD card, but please don't connect them in same time, otherwise may confuse you where the files are saved (Normally device will recognize the lasted connected one, but in play mode it will be different)

When the turntable playing and an USB flash or Micro SD card is connecting, and the device is under standby mode (green indicator keep on), and the color of indicator is green shows it at default

manually mode. Just simply press the recording button then the device will start to recording (converting) the playing music to MP3 format, the green indicator will be quick flashing (if not, means not recording, re-plug your USB flash and try again). Press the recording button again to stop recording and save a MP3 file in USB flash.

At the interval between two songs where you want to save in another file, short press ∇ button, the flashing green indicator will be off about 2 seconds, then quick flash again to save in another file.

If you want do it at auto mode, simple at standby mode long press ∇ button 3~5 seconds, till you see the indicator from green to blue.

On auto mode, ezcap613 will detect each interval between two songs, and will save them in two files. So normally, if you have 4 songs at side A(or B) of your vinyl, just put it on and play, then press record button, after 4 songs played, will automatic save 4 mp3 files in your USB flash (or SD).

Device will create a new folder name "TAPEMP3" in your USB disk (or SD), and save each MP3 name "FV0001 to FV9999"

If you want to switch back to manual mode from auto mode, stop recording(or playback) to standby mode (blue indicator keeps on), long press ∇ button 3~5 seconds, till you see the indicator from blue to green, or simply power off ezcap613, then power on again, it will load at default----manually mode .

Playback:

The device with playback function so you can easily checking the recorded file.

At standby mode, press playback button, device will start to play the recording music, the indicator will be slow flashing. Press playback button again, will stop playback and back to standby mode. During playback, use

up/down button \triangle ∇ to choose play previous or next file. Use +/- button to set volume up and down.

You can also copy other MP3 file to USB flash and plug to our device to replay it, but only files in "TAPEMP3" folder can be played.
