Introduction

Please read below before you start your unique journey with your very own inWatch Z:

Please turn your inWatch Z off when you are near chemical plants, gas stations or other explosives.

Please don't use inWatch Z during flight.

Please don't use near heart pacemakers, hearing aids and other medical electrical equipment; your inWatch Z will interfere these devices.

Please don't disassemble, repair or modify inWatch Z. Please contact our post-sale service center if there is any problem.

Please keep your inWatch Z away from magnetic materials, such as disks, credit cards and so forth, in order to avoid degaussing.

Please do not expose your inWatch Z to extreme temperatures. Prolonged direct sunlight or humid environments should also be avoided. (Please see Environmental Requirements)

A Look At Your inWatch Z

Hardware and Design of inWatch Z

When you open the package, please check to make sure that the box includes:

1. inWatch Z
2. inWatch Z USB charger
3. Smart watch adapted USB cable

Power key/ Screen lock key

Press this key to turn on/off the watch and lock the screen.

Please input the password if needed.

Continue to press the power key for 15 seconds to reset the watch, which has the same effect as removing and reinserting the battery.

Hardware and Design of inWatch Z

inWatch Z supports a micro SIM card. It can save a lot of data for communication. You can save your personal information, including PIN code, contact list, messages and other data from extra system services.

Before using inWatch Z, please open the SIM card slot and insert the SIM card into the tray. Warning: Please don't twist or scratch the SIM card, and keep it away from static electricity, dust and water.

Please turn off inWatch Z before you install the SIM card. Put the SIM card into the watch as illustrated below.

Warning: Please keep the SIM card and tray away from children.

Using the inWatch Z Bone Conduction Speaker

The rectangular rubber piece on the wrist band is a bone conduction speaker. Press it against any flat object (i.e. box, desk etc.), and the sound emitted will be amplified, allowing for operation as a speakerphone.

How to Wear inWatch Z

When putting on your inWatch Z, please align the clasp, push from behind slightly then press down.

How to Adjust the Wristband

After adjusting the size of the wristband, the position of the clasp will be different. You need to adjust the steel pin to find the most comfortable wristband.

How to Use the Included USB Charger

inWatch Z uses external conductive contacts to charge. Open the included charging clip and align it to the contacts under the wristband, close the clip and connect the included USB cable for charging.

inWatch Z features a built-in 580 MAH battery, the performance of which could be influenced by many factors such as network configuration, signal strength, temperature, user settings, and mobile phone accessories used besides voice, data or other application modes.

In order to achieve the best battery performance, please observe the following guidelines:

It takes a longer time to charge a new battery or one that has been unused for a prolonged period of time.

When charging, keep the battery at or near ambient temperature.

As with all rechargeable batteries, after long-term use it will take a longer period of time to charge due to gradual capacity loss. Please note that this is a normal phenomenon.

If battery is unused for some time, or when battery power is low, a certain interval of time is needed before the normal charging display screen appears. Please wait patiently.

If the watch is off while charging, the screen will display an image similar to the one below.

1. The Main Page

When first turning on inWatch Z or pushing the "HOME" button, the main page will display the time, telephone icon, camera icon and date. Touch the date and time to switch to weather.

When a user is on the main page, they can scroll by swiping down or left, as shown below.

In general, the screen will display the following content when you swipe down on the main page: time, date and inWatch Z's basic settings, including airplane mode, battery level indicator, WLAN, GPS, data connection, volume etc.

2. App Center

The App Center includes the following basic apps: Calendar, Calculator, Clock, E-mail, Camera, Photo album, Music, Video Player, Voice Recorder, To-Do List, Document Manager, Settings, Telephone, Contacts, Messages, Browser, Compatible, Ledongli (exercise app), Voice Assistant.

Tap the "Application" icon to enter Application Center.

3. Dialing

inWatch Z can keep a history of incoming, outgoing and missed calls.

Touch the "Phone" icon to enter dialing mode:

1. Input a phone number, then press the "Call" button.
2. Press "Call Record" at the bottom-left corner to access the list of recent calls.
3. Press "Contacts" in the lower-right corner to access your list of contact names and phone numbers.

Note: To make international calls, press "0" for a few seconds to get the symbol "+", then input the country code (no need to add "00") and phone number.

4. Telephone

Tap the "Phone" icon to access the dialing page.

When an incoming or outgoing call, the screen will display the calling page, which will show the call status and the call's contact information.

Tap the upper-left icon to open or cancel "hands free".

Tap the upper-middle icon to end the call.

Tap the upper-right icon to mute or unmute the microphone.

Tap the lower-left icon to open the keyboard.

Tap the lower-middle icon to pause the call.

Tap the lower-right icon to add more contacts to the call.

5. Input

inWatch Z uses the Sudoku input keyboard and handwriting input method.

inWatch Z also has the YunZhiSheng voice input system built-in. You can change the input method on the "Language and input" Settings screen.

6. Calculator

inWatch Z features a simple built-in calculator.

Tap the "Calculator" icon in the App Center to access the calculator.

Because of the inWatch Z's limited screen space, the calculator's input keyboard is divided into two sections. You can swipe left and right to switch

7. Messages

Tap the "Messages" icon in the App Center to access the messaging app.

Tap the message that you want to read to display its full content.

Tap the icon in the upper-left corner to edit the messages list.

You can type number in "To" field, or select a contact from address book.

You can compose new messages in the "Type" field. Touch "send" button to deliver the message after finishing editing.

inWatch Z supports the sending of MMS content. Touch the "+" at the lower-left corner of the screen to add an attachment.

8. Contacts

Tap the "Contacts" icon in the App Center to access the contacts page.

Contacts are arranged in alphabetical order, and only names are displayed on the first page of the phonebook.

You can type the name of the contact you want to access in the input box at the top of the screen to search.

There are several locations to save contacts' information, including: inWatch memory, micro SIM card and to a smart phone set up for synchronization with your inWatch.

Contacts' information include: name, company name, three phone numbers (mobile number, home number, work number), e-mail, fax number, chat icon, etc.

After dialing a number on the calling screen, you can touch the lower-right corner to access the "Contacts" page. Then tapping the "create a new contact" button on the bottom, you can add the number to the phonebook.

9. Calendar

Tap the "Calendar" icon in the App Center to access the electronic calendar.

inWatch Z's built-in calendar can display the solar calendar, Chinese lunar date and solar term. You can choose to display by month, week, or day.

To create an event, select the date and time you need. Enter the event information such as event name, location, time, etc.

10. E-mail

To setup your email account when you use it for the first time, select the email setup assistant. Input your password to complete account configuration. You can then write and receive emails.

11. Album

inWatch Z can store pictures taken with the built-in camera to the photo album.

Tap the "Album" icon in the App Center to access the album, where your photos will be arranged and displayed.

You can also create individual albums to manage your photos more efficiently.

Touch the cover of the album to open the album. inWatch Z will display the album's photos in a grid. Touch each picture to view in full-screen mode. To check the next or previous picture, drag to the left or right.

12. Music Player

inWatch Z's built-in music player supports the use of a Bluetooth headset. Supported formats include: MP3, WMA, WAV, 3GP, MP4 and WMV.

Touch the "Music" icon in the App Center to enter the music player.

The Player page shows the information for the song that is currently playing. You can pause or continue playback by tapping the middle of the screen.

Tap the upper-left corner to access the playlist.

You can play a song by tapping its title on the playlist page.

Tap the upper-right corner to toggle shuffle mode on or off.

Tap middle-left to replay the currently playing song. Tap it twice to go to the previous song.

Tap middle-right to skip to the next song.

By sliding your finger across the playback progress bar you can adjust the playback volume.

13. Video

inWatch Z features a built-in video player. The playback formats supported include: AVI, RM, RMVB and ASF.

Tap the "Video" icon in the App Center to enter the video folder. Video preview screens are displayed in a grid. You can tap any preview to play the video.

After accessing the playback screen, the current video's name will be displayed at the top of the screen, you can tap the button next to the name to share the video.

By tapping the middle of the screen, you can pause or resume video playback.

The bar at the bottom of the video displays playback progress.

Tap the lower-right corner to enter full-screen mode.

14. Clock

inWatch Z' s built-in clock features alarms, a timer, and a stopwatch.

15. Audio Recorder

Tap the play key to start recording, the upper middle of the screen is the timer, after you finish recording, touch the icon "X" to save or cancel.

16. ToDo

ToDo allows you to setup reminders to help you stay on schedule.

17. Document management

You can view all the documents in your inWatch Z' s Android filesystem, and can change the way it is sorted order. You can also set up a new folder and edit its contents.

18. Voice Assistant

You can open the main menu and call someone using voice commands (i.e. tap the microphone icon and say: open camera, or open message, or call "Gary", etc)

19. inClub

1) Download inClub

You can download inClub from the inWatch' s official website, or search it from the AppMarket.

2) inClub function

inClub is an application to connect your inWatch Z to inWatch' s cloud services. Input your inClub ID to login. iCloud provides private cloud storage, quick setting the smart watch, remind you the incoming call and message from the cell phone. inClub is still under development and more features will be added in future updates.

3) inClub operation instruction

a. Download and launch the inClub app on your smartphone. Make sure that Bluetooth is enabled on both your smartphone and inWatch Z, and that they are within connection range of each other. Pair them from within the inClub app.

b. Use your Baidu ID to register and login (Your Baidu ID will serve as your inWatch ID).

c. Tap the upper-right corner to find "account management" and set up your account information. This includes your avatar, nickname, WeChat QR code, etc.

d. Touch the upper-right corner to find "watch setup". You can quickly set up incoming call reminders, message reminders, and set the device' s time here.

e. Touch the upper-right corner to find "Check for updates" to check if any software updates are available for the inWatch Z.

20. Compatibility settings

If a third-party app does not display correctly, try activating this option. The inWatch Z' s operating system will attempt to adjust applications to better fit the device' s display.
