

# **TVPRO** OVERVIEW





Power Button

Start TVPRO by short press; shut down the TVPRO by long press.



**Dual Microphones** 

Dual noise cancelling microphones support hands free video conference up to 15ft+.



**Dual Speakers** 

TVPRO has dual speakers to provide an independent audio solution when using with a display or monitor that has no audio.



1080p HD Webcam

TVPRO has a full 1080p HD webcam that brings a high quality live video conferencing solution to any TV.



(2) USB ports

## TVPRO SET UP

#### **Key Navigation Buttons:**



Back

Opens the previous screen you were working in, even if it was in a different app. Once you back up to the Home screen, you can't go back any further.



Home

Opens the central Home screen. To open Google Now, swipe up.



Opens a list of thumbnail images of apps you've worked with recently. To open an app, touch it. To remove a thumbnail from the list, swipe it left or right.



#### AIR MOUSE FUNCTIONS



#### Change mouse pointer speed (4 levels):


Pressing • and • at the same time for 3 sec with speed up or slow down the air mouse movement level. The red and blue LED will flash 1-4 times to indicate the mouse speed setting.

#### IR remote control learning function:

Pressing and at the same time for 3 sec will activate the IR learning mode and indicator LED will start flashing. Next, press and release the IR Key that you want to code and the LED will flash slower. Place the air mouse remote IR emitter directly pointing 1cm away from the other remote IR and press the button on that remoted that you want to be learned. The IR LED will go from flashing to constant indicating the code has been sucessfully learned.

## AIR MOUSE FUNCTIONS

#### Code Pairing the Remote and Nano Key:

If the remote does not connect automatically, you will need to pair with the nano key by pressing • and • buttons at the same time and hold for 3 seconds. The remote LED will flash rapidly, re-insert the USB nano key and hold the remote close to the receiver in 30cm, when code pairing succeeds, the LED will slowly flash 3 times.

#### Use the Air Mouse Function:

Click on the respective side of the remote to start the air mouse which allows the cursor to move in any direction the remote is pointed. Pressing any key when the "Qwerty" keyboard side is up will rotate the mouse orientation 90 degrees to compensate and pressing any of the directional arrow keys will stop the air mouse function.

#### Power Saving Mode:

The air mouse function will stop if no movement of the remote for 30 seconds or if no buttons are clicked for 10 minutes the remote will enter power saving mode.

#### Zero Drift Correction and Calibration:

If the mouse cursor drifts without movement of the remote, just make the remote stay still 3-4 seconds on a desk to eliminate the drift. Calibrate cursor accurancy by moving it to an edge of the TV until it stops and then point the remote directly at the cursor to align.

#### **Recharging Battery:**

When the remote battery is low the power LED will rapidly flash red. Recharge the lithium-ion battery by connecting the remote with the micro USB cable to a computer or 5v DC power supply. During recharging the power status LED will flash green and red until the battery is full and the light will remain green. The total recharging time is about 60 to 90 minutes.
