#### 1 Product Introduction

#### 1.1 Package Contents

#### Standard Swimmer Package

- Waterproof earphones
- USB cable (for track download and recharge)
- User's Manual

- Arm Band
- Drying cloth


## 1.2 System Requirements

Prior to using the product, confirm that the operation system of your PC meets one of the following requirements:

Windows 98SE/Windows 2000/Windows ME/Windows XP or Mac OS 8.6

# 1.3 General Specifications

- Waterproofing: International Standard IPX8
- MP3/WMA supported
- Battery life: Playing continuously for 5-6 hours (depending on user's operation habits)
- Firmware updating, file transmission and storage, and battery recharge via USB
- Operation temperature under water: 0°C~+50°C; humidity: 20% ~100%
- Dimensions: 60mm (length) x 21mm (width) x21mm (height)
- Body net weight: 25g

#### 2. Operational Instructions

#### 2.1. Copy MP3 Files from PC to the MP3 Player

- · Connect the player to the USB port of your PC using the attached USB cable.
- A " icon appears at the right bottom of the Tool Bar. A "Removable Disk" icon also appears in "My Computer".
- Use the File Manager function to copy MP3 files to the player.
- Then double-click the "see" icon at the right bottom of the Tool Bar to disable the "Removable Disk". When the "This Disk Has Been Disabled Successfully" dialog box appears, disconnect the player from the USB port.

#### 2.2 Recharge the Battery

There are two ways to recharge the battery:


- To recharge the battery via USB port of your PC or NB, simply connect the player using the USB cable to your PC or NB. Only 1.5 hours are required to fully recharge the battery.
- To recharge the battery using the USB charger (optional), simply connect the player to the charger using the USB cable, then connect the charger to the power supply.
- Note: When disconnected from the USB port after recharging or file transmission, the player switches off automatically.

#### 2.3 Operation in Water (Swimming Mode)

- Lock the player to the swimming goggles with the attached lock ring and fix the earphones behind your ears with the clip.
- Press and hold the " ()" for 3-4 seconds to turn on the player (The LED indicator comes on ) and enter playback mode.
- Wipe the player dry with the attached Drying cloth as soon as you leave the water.

#### 2.4 Special Features (Optional)

In the Sports Extra Accessory Package, a thermal sensor ( $\pm 1^{-3}$ °C) is available for the lock ring of the swimming goggles. It provides water temperature indications for users swimming in water environments at different temperatures. The meter of the sensor is shown below:



- \*You may refer to the above meter and compare it with the temperatures below when wearing the goggles with the thermal sensor and swimming in water environments at different temperatures:
- A. About 5 °C/ ice water pool of sauna
- B. 8~14°C/ cold water pool of sauna C. 17~21°C/ normal swimming pool
- D. 25~28 °C/ tepid swimming pool
- E. 36~40 °C/ hot bath
- F. 40~43 °C/ hot spring=hot water pool of sauna

#### 3. How to Wear the Player

#### 3.1 Swimming

Before swimming, wear the player according to steps below to ensure the waterproof protection:

Be sure to use the waterproof earphones.
 Step 1 as illustrated below:




• Take the earphone plug into the earphone socket on the player.



3. As shown in the following figures, lock the MP3 player to the band of the swimming goggles with the lock ring and pull it tightly. Adjust the clip of the earphones and clip it at a proper position on the band of the swimming goggles. (For swimming).



#### 4. Operating Environments

The player can function appropriately in the following environments:

- Swimming/Hot spring/Sauna/Spa/surfing/snorkeling/windsurfing and other water activities
- Normal environment

#### 5. Troubleshooting

This section provides significant information to help you solve common problems you might encounter when using the product. If you encounter any problems that are not listed below, contact your dealer for professional help.

#### 5.1 I can't turn on the MP3 player

 It possibly results from power shortage of the battery. Connect to your PC for recharging using the USB cable.

# 5.2 After I turn on the MP3 player, it shuts down again in no time.

 It possibly results from low charge of the battery. Connect to your PC or the optional USB charger for recharging using the USB cable.

#### 5.3 I can't use the USB cable or charger to recharge my player

- Be sure that you are using the USB cable attached in the package for recharging.
- Connect the player to your PC using the USB cable and check that the operating system is picking up the MP3 player.

Unplug the USB and plug it in again. Press the 

button at the same time to reset the settings to default before you start the recharging.

#### 5.4 There is no sound after the player is turned on.

- Be sure that the earphones are properly plugged into the earphone socket.
   If you are using the waterproof earphones, be sure to screw them tightly into the earphone socket.
- The volume might be too low. Use Volume Up V oI+ button to increase the volume.

#### 5.5 Abnormality occurs during the operation.

- If there is still no sound during operation of the player with the earphones
  plugged in the right position and the LED indicator flashing normally
  press the buttons at the same time and restart the player.
- If the LED indicator stays on but the player does not work, press the buttons at the same time and restart the player to reset the settings to default.
- Note: The files stored in the player will not be lost due to the reset.

#### 5.6 I can't connect my MP3 player to PC

- Be sure that you have connected the player to your PC appropriately using the USB cable.
- If you are using Windows 98, go to our website and download the MP3 player driver for Windows 98. Make sure that the driver is installed appropriately.
