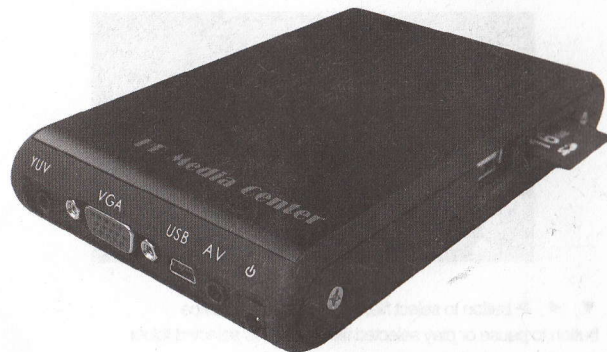


## 2.5" HDD Media Player

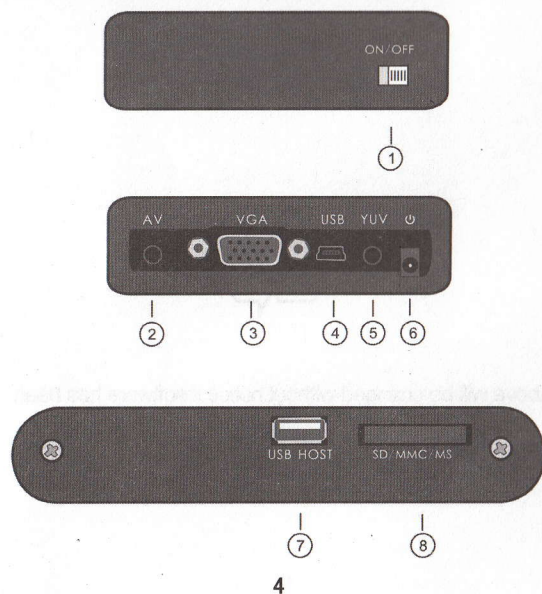

### 1.1 Interface

## Part IV File Management

### NOTES:

- ◆ All editing must be made at "FILE" (or file library) mode;
- ◆ File management can't be made in NTFS system devices.

### 4.1 Copy (or Move) Files

Firstly, select one folder (or file) and then press the "DVD/TARGET" button to make it (or the folder where the file is located) as the destination folder.

Secondly, select the file you want to copy (or move), press the "INFO/EDIT" button, and then select "COPY" (or "MOVE"). This file will be copied (or moved) to the destination folder.

### 4.2 Delete Files (or Folder)

Select the file you want to delete, press the "INFO/EDIT" button, and then select "DELETE". This file (or folder) will be deleted soon.

### 4.3 Rename Files (or Folder)

Select the file you want to rename, press the "INFO/EDIT" button, and then select "RENAME". A keyboard will appear on the screen. Enter a new name with the direction keys, and then press "STOP" key (marked with "■") on the remote to finish the rename.

## 4.4 Create New Folders

Enter into a folder where you want to create a new folder, press the "INFO/EDIT" button, and then select "NEW FOLDER". A keyboard will appear on the screen. Enter a name for the new folder with the direction keys, and then press "STOP" key (marked with "■") to finish the name. And lastly a new folder will be created.

## 4.5 Check Properties

Select the file you want to check, press the "INFO/EDIT" button, and then select "PROPERTIES". All detailed properties of the file will appear on the screen.

## Part V Setup

Press "SETUP" button to enter Setup page.

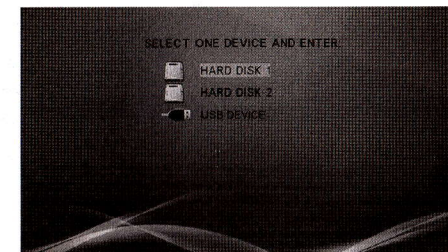

## Part III Playback

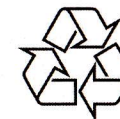
Power on the unit, and then 1) it will auto play (Boot Priority: card, then USB drive, and last internal HDD); or 2) the screen will show following main page:



- ▲, ▼, ◀, ▶ button to select file, folder or storage device
- | button to pause or play selected file; to enter to selected folder
- button to stop playing current file
- ◀ button to return to parent directory or the main page
- ◀, ▶ button to decrease / increase volume during movie or music playback

You can enter into "MOVIE", "MUSIC", "PHOTO" or "FILE" mode by the shortcut button with same name on the remote control.
